We hope to rebuild her to reflect the boat that Dale had "rescued" from Maine in 1931, and brought her to Bay Head where she was used to carry lumber used to build parts of Dale Yacht Basin. She was later converted to a pleasure craft.

We were very lucky to find Model Ships by Thomas Lauria of Yarmouthport, MA. We shared reference materials and Tom kept us up-to-date with frequent photos.
